**BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

**JUNE 6, 2017**

Meeting called to order at 5:15 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board Members in attendance were the following: Micky Alexander, Nancy Doss, Linda Blanche, Wiley Doss, Jim Semanek, Sue Levine, Carol Walker & Tony Head. Also in attendance were Guy Clear, Brenda Head, Bob Hill & Mary Kincaid.

Minutes of the May 2017 meeting were approved following a motion by Tony Head and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim Semanek.

Treasurer: Checking account balance is \$5144.11. The report for the month of May was passed out and with no questions or corrections it was accepted as presented.

President's remarks: All the award plaques, through 2016 have been updated. The SCCA General Manager has now directed the maintenance department employees to ask for your Association Membership Card, with your picture, anytime you ask them to open our bowling facilities. Hemet has asked that we look into them renting our aerator. Tony Head reported that previously, the SCCA Board suggested that we might rent this equipment out to help recover some of the cost & 1% of the purchase price was mentioned, which would be \$150. But now we have a different Board so we have to see what their thoughts are. Tom also said that our maintenance department would have to deliver & operate the aerator so there most likely would also be a charge for labor.

Greens: In the absence of the greens director, Tony Head mentioned that the maintenance department needs to reduce the height of the mower from ¼' to 1/8" and he would check with them.

Grounds: Still waiting to hear from Tom Wellingham regarding the replacement of backboard carpet on the upper green. Working on painting the Hog Line 'Pigs' on the upper green.

Visitations: June 15<sup>th</sup>, Hemet. Sign-up sheet posted. Evelyn Tiel will be handling this in Carol Walker's absence. They need to know how many will be coming by the Monday prior. September 21<sup>st</sup> is an ice cream social & bowling here. Also on October 26<sup>th</sup> is a dinner & bowling sponsored by Hemet.

Hospitality: This month's Birthday celebration will be on the last day of the Mixed Pairs. Brenda Head is bringing the cake & will take care of serving. July birthdays will be celebrated along with the July 4<sup>th</sup> BBQ. Wiley Doss volunteered to bring the cake. Sue Levine posted a sign-up sheet for salads & condiments. John Derbique was nominated to be our chef for the BBQ. He will be asked. It was decided to serve Bratwurst & Hamburgers. Beer & Wine will be served. We will start at 5pm with bowling afterwards. A \$50 deposit must be given to the Association to make sure the BBQ is returned in a clean condition. We must also make sure it is in a clean condition when we receive it for our use. The club will pay for the meat & buns.
